Quality of Writing	Grammar, usage of language, mechanics, and spelling are error-free or nearly error-free, and a professional tone is maintained throughout	Errors in grammar, usage of language, mechanics, and or spelling are present on several occasions; a professional tone is maintained through most of the work	Errors in grammar, usage of language, mechanics, and or spelling are distracting and serious; the tone is professional only about half of the time	Errors in grammar, usage of language, mechanics, and or spelling are very distracting and serious; the tone is not professional
